**Classes will meet from 9:00-12:00 and 1:00-4:00. One class will be held in the morning and the other class will be held in the afternoon. The remaining coursework will be done online. Professors may choose to hold some synchronous classes, but much of the work will be asynchronous.**

**AMLA 602 (research methodologies for the 2nd year cohort) and AMLA 604 (motivating students via technology for the 1st year cohort) will be held fully online with a mix of synchronous and**

**asynchronous class sessions. These courses will begin June 6 and will wrap up by Aug. 12. All coursework will be due Aug. 12.**

Summer Meal Rates in **Campus Dining**: \$5.88 breakfast; \$8.22 lunch; \$9.36 dinner; a firm number for each meal is needed 2 weeks in advance. These current prices will probably see a 3-4% increase. **We can expect a cost of approximately \$6.12 for breakfast, \$8.55 for lunch, and \$9.73 for dinner. We will confirm these when BSU publishes their 2022 rates.**

\$5.88 x 10 breakfasts = 58.80

\$8.22 x 10 lunches = 82.20

**Approximate cost of meals = 243.96**

\$9.36 x 11 dinners = \$102.96

\$363 (room) + \$243.96 (meals) = \$606.96

**Suggested price of room and board = \$625**

**Classrooms** = \$100 per day; 10 days for 2 classrooms will be approximately \$2,000.

A new two week and one session begins on June 20, allowing staff and students to send children to camp if desired. Long-time CLV staff will receive their discount on overnight camps.
